The Prescott Area Winter Shelter (PAWS) was the recipient of 21 quilts, 15 pairs of mittens and two hats from the Lonesome Valley Quilt Guild to assist PAWS. PAWS is an emergency winter shelter for homeless/transitional women and children during the months of December 2007 through February 2008 with 15 beds available.
